As we celebrate the 35th anniversary of New Vistas School, we would like to take this opportunity to update you on the outstanding progress of the Mind-Body-Spirit Capital Campaign. Thanks to the overwhelming generosity of numerous friends of the school, we are moving closer toward this very important project becoming a reality to benefit our students, providing them with a dedicated space to exercise, play, and learn, now and in the years to come.

As noted in the original case statement, the purpose of the campaign is to add a first-ever gymnasium, two science classrooms, and an art classroom, enhancing every child's educational experience. Since the inception of the campaign in 2018, a new playground component has been added, creating additional outdoor play space.

We are pleased to share that, to date, we have raised over \$1.2 million to fund this project that will reap daily benefits for our students, providing them with new and exciting resources to help them become well-rounded, educated, productive citizens. This fundraising milestone is quite an accomplished community effort, especially to have done so in less than four years and during a global crisis.

As a result of unforeseen challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic, as well as unexpected market shifts, the campaign has incurred increased costs of materials and supply shortages, and we are currently re-estimating the total project cost to provide the New Vistas School community with a revised fundraising goal. We want to assure the community that we will be moving forward with construction as soon as final plans are approved in upcoming months. Students will thrive from a newly installed playground on the front lawn of our beautiful campus around the start of the 2022-2023 school year.

At this pivotal time in the campaign, thank you for your continued interest in New Vistas School and your support of our efforts to fully fund this critical and impactful project. We look forward to sharing continued updates with you about the plans for construction. We are grateful for your ongoing support of our mission to provide children with learning, attention, and emotional challenges with the opportunities to reach their full potential.
